Year Plan 2021-2022

This Year Plan is intended to help students acquire the basic language skills so that they can function in every-day situations. Attention will be given to the development of the four skills of language-learning: speaking, reading, listening and writing. Students should be able to understand and reproduce the language as spoken and written simply, on every-day topics. Teachers will employ an acceptable method (or a combination) to bring about the desired objective. Exercises geared towards the development of the given language skills will both be receptive and productive.

This will include:

- Listening and reading comprehension.
- Reading aloud to reproduce the sounds and form of the foreign language
- Participating in simple conversations on everyday topics
- Responding to situations
- Translations into target language
- Completing dialogues
- Writing simple letters and compositions.

Students will be exposed to the cultural practices of French speaking countries and will be encouraged to participate in French festivals, quiz competitions, field trips, modern languages club, exhibitions and, hopefully, trips to French countries.
